

Benchmarks of Quality (BOQ) results


LES scores 100% on this year's Benchmarks of Quality for the 2nd year in a row! Results for the BOQ are derived from the LES PBIS Team. Members of the team fill out a rating form, the responses from those forms are tallied, and the most frequent response determines the rate for each item. Each rating is entered into a data base which generates an overall score.




EOY stuff
